I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the flock of origin meet the following requirements:

the United Kingdom has an official surveillance plan for NAI in place that has been carried out in the establishment within the past 21 days;

ii.\* OR

a representative sample of the parent flock(s) (60 birds or the entire parent flock if the total number of birds in the parent flock is less than 60) was subjected to a diagnostic test on cloacal swabs (PCR or VI) within the 21 days prior to shipment to demonstrate freedom from infection with NAI; (Cloacal samples can be pooled to a maximum of 5 swabs per vial.)
