HEALTH ATTESTATION

I, the undersigned, certify that:

1. PORCINE COLLAGEN CASINGS

- (i) The products described above have been produced in an officially approved facility under the authority and supervision of the competent veterinary authority.
- (ii) The product has been derived from pigs which were slaughtered in approved abattoirs where they were subjected to ante- and post mortem veterinary inspections and considered fit for human consumption in accordance with European Community legislation.

2. BOVINE COLLAGEN CASINGS

- (i) bovine hides from which the collagen was produced were split/harvested in an officially approved facility under the authority and supervision of the competent veterinary authority.
- (ii) bovine hides/tendons were obtained from bovine animals which were tested for BSE with negative result or from animals younger than 72 months.
- (iii) during manufacture and storage in the United Kingdom, the collagen has not come into contact with products likely to contain BSE infectivity (specified risk material) in accordance with the EU Regulation 2004/853/EC and Section XV requirements for control of collagen for human consumption.
- (iv) the collagen was from bovine animals, which passed ante mortem and post mortem inspection and the collagen was produced in accordance with the following procedure:
 - a) alkali treatment at a pH not less than 12 for at least 48 hrs;
 - b) neutralisation of pH;

c) extraction by acid at a pH of 3.3 or more for at least 48 hrs at ambient temperature;

d) drying at 80°C:

3. After production, the collagen was packed in an impermeable wrapping material which prevents subsequent contamination.
