- c) The farm(s) of origin of the eggs/birds and any other immediately surrounding farms have not been subjected during the 6 months prior to export to any official restrictions due to any notifiable infectious or transmissible disease that may affect poultry;
- d) The farm(s) of origin of the eggs/birds are officially certified free of Mycoplasmosis (M. gallisepticum and M. synoviae) and Salmonellosis (due to S. enterifidis, S. pullorum and S. gallinarum);
- e) The farm(s) of origin has/have shown no clinical signs or evidence of Salmonellosis (due to S. arizonae and S. typhimurium).
