PART II: CERTIFICATION

HEALTH ATTESTATION

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, declare that I am aware of the relevant provisions of Regulations (EC) No 178/2002, (EC) No 852/2004 and (EC) No 853/2004, and certify that:

1. Collagen casings have been produced from the skins/hides (hide splits) of healthy bovine animals, which have passed ante mortem and post mortem inspection and been found fit for human consumption;
2. Bovine hide splits are under periodical veterinary supervision;
3. Collagen casings have been produced in accordance with a procedure that includes the following stages:
 - a. alkali treatment in the interval of pH not less than 11 for at least 48h;
 - b. neutralisation;
 - c. extraction by acid at pH up to a maximum of 3,3 for at least 48h at ambient temperature;
 - d. drying.
4. Collagen casings are produced in the premises which are regularly disinfected and under a constant sanitary supervision;
5. Collagen casings are packed in an impermeable wrapping material which prevents subsequent contamination.
