I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin meet the following requirements:

- a) the ducklings come from farms of origin which are members of a government supervised poultry health scheme, in full accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC, which applies and exceeds all the requirements of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code, and as such they are subject to regular official veterinary inspection;

- b) there has been no evidence of the presence of **duck viral enteritis** or **duck viral hepatitis** on the farms of origin during the 12 months prior to export;
- c) there has been no evidence of the presence of **avian mycoplasmosis** on the farms of origin or the hatchery during the 12 months prior to export;
- d) The farm(s) of origin are members of a government supervised Poultry Health Scheme which fully implements EU Directive 2009/158/EC, and as such they have been subject to routine testing for **Salmonella gallinarum** (fowl typhoid) and **S.pullorum** (pullorum disease) with negative results in each case;
- e) the parent flocks of the ducklings were
 EITHER* not vaccinated for **Newcastle disease**,
 OR* vaccinated for Newcastle disease as follows:
