## IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) on (date) I inspected the bird(s)\* immediately prior to export and found it/them\* to be healthy and free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, external parasites and bit to travel;
- b) the United Kingdom is officially free from highly pathogenic notifiable avian influenza (sub-types H5 or H7) according to the criteria of the OIE;
- to the best of my knowledge and belief and after due enquiry, there has been no history or clinical evidence of infectious bursal disease (Gumboro disease), Newcastle disease, Marek's disease, Mycoplasmosis (M. gallisepticum), fowl typhoid (Salmonella gallinarum), pullorum disease (Salmonella pullorum), fowl pox, avian infectious bronchitis, avian infectious laryngotracheitis, avian tuberculosis, chlamydiosis (psittacosis/ornithosis), fowl cholera (Pasteurellosis), Salmonella enteritidis, Salmonella typhimurium, Egg drop syndrome, infectious avian encephalomyelitis, chicken anaemia, avian J virus, African Nile virus and inclusion body hepatitis in the establishment or zoo during the past 12 months;
- d) to the best of my belief and based on a written declaration from the owner/exporter none of the birds has been vaccinated for Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (H5 & H7 subtype) and none has ever shown a positive serological test result for highly pathogenic avian influenza.

- e) the birds for export have been kept in pre-export isolation at the premises at paragraph II (b) for at least the last 30 days prior to export, or since hatching;
- f) the birds were kept under veterinary supervision for 45 days prior to export and were treated against Psittacosis-Ornithosis (Avian Chlamydiosis) using Chlortetracycline;
- I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter that the birds will be transported in new, clean containers which conform with IATA requirements;
- h) during the pre-export isolation period, the birds were treated against ectoparasites and endoparasites.
