IV. Health Information

- I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that the day-old birds described above meet the following requirements:
- a) The United Kingdom, where the flocks of origin and the hatchery are located is officially free from notifiable avian influenza (NAI) according to the criteria of the OIE;
- b) The flocks of origin are located in a poultry establishment in the UK which is officially free from Newcastle disease according to the criteria of the OIE;
- c) vaccination of poultry for avian influenza is not permitted in the UK and the flock(s) of origin have not been vaccinated against avian influenza;
- d) The flocks of origin have been resident in the UK for at least 90 days or since hatching;
- e) the flock(s) of origin are subject to regular official veterinary inspection there has been no evidence of clinical symptoms of infectious disease at the flock(s) of origin during the 90 days immediately prior to shipment;
- f) there has been no evidence of the following diseases in the flock(s) of origin during the 6 months immediately prior to shipment:
 - Avian Pseudotuberculosis, Avian tuberculosis, Infectious coryza, Newcastle disease (ND), fowl pox, fowl cholera (Pasteurella multocida), fowl typhoid (Salmonella gallinarum), pullorum disease (Salmonella pullorum), infectious bronchitis(IB), Infectious Laryngotracheis (ILT), infectious synovitis, infectious bursal disease (IBD), egg drop syndrome, ornithosis, Marek's disease, lymphoid leucosis, mycoplasmosis, chronic respiratory disease(CRD), swollen head syndrome, avian nephritis, chick anaemia agent, leucocytozoonosis, avian spirochaetosis, avian encephalomyelitis, Salmonella enteritidis and Salmonella typhimurium;
- g) The flocks of origin of the day-old birds have undergone a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC with negative results to serological or bacteriological tests for: Salmonella pullorum (Pullorum disease) and S.gallinarum (Fowl thypoid); (a copy of the latest laboratory report is attached);
- h) The flocks of origin of the day-old birds have undergone a disease surveillance programme similar to that required by EU Regulation 2160/2003 with negative results for: Salmonella enteritidis and S.typhimurium (a copy of the latest laboratory report is attached);
- j) the day-old birds have not been vaccinated
- k) the day-old birds been hatched in hatcheries which are members of a government supervised poultry health scheme and it is a condition of the Scheme that eggs are sanitised prior to incubation, and that hatchery equipment is sanitised prior to use, and that high standards of bio-security are maintained;
- I have this day examined the day-old birds for export and found no clinical sign of disease, and in my opinion they are fit for the intended journey;

- m) The boxes in which the day-old birds are packed for export are new, unused and clean, and contain only the birds certified in this certificate;
- n) The vehicles for the transport of the day-old birds have been cleaned and disinfected prior to use with approved disinfectants.
