- (a) comes from birds slaughtered in abattoirs /processing plants which are accredited for export in the United Kingdom;
- (b) The birds from which the product has been produced have been bred, hatched, grown, slaughtered and further processed in the United Kingdom;
- (c) The meat does not have residues of pesticides, drugs, mycotoxins and chemicals above the Maximum Residue Limits prescribed internationally;
- (d) comes from birds slaughtered in abattoirs and processed in processing plants where no ruminant or porcine tissue/ protein has been used in the production of meat or has been added to the meat at any stage;
- (e) the United Kingdom is officially free from Notifiable Avian Influenza (Highly Pathogenic and Low Pathogenic) as defined in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code;
- (f) The consignment comes from birds which were kept in establishments where the incidence of the following diseases has not been reported during the 12 months prior to slaughter:
  - \*(in the case of chickens, quails and guinea fowls), Newcastle Disease, Marek's disease, Avian Mycoplasmosis, Haemorrhagic and Infectious synovitis/sinusitis, enteritis chlamydiosis, Fowl typhoid, Avian infectious bronchitis, Avian infectious laryngotracheitis, Fowl cholera and Salmonella enteritidis Salmonella typhimurium, Avian Leucosis J virus infections, Inclusion body hepatitis ( Hydropericardium), bursal disease, Infectious Pullorum disease, Fowl tuberculosis, pox, Egg drop syndrome, encephalomyelitis and Chicken anaemia virus;
