- c) The flocks of origin have undergone a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC with negative results for:  
**Salmonella pullorum, S.gallinarum, and Mycoplasma gallisepticum;**
- d) The flocks of origin have undergone a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Regulation 2160/2003 with negative results for:  
**Salmonella enteritidis, S.typhimurium, S.infantis, S.virchow, and S.hadar;**
- e) the flocks of origin are subject to routine monthly veterinary inspection in accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC governing intra-Community trade in live poultry and do not show any signs or suspicion of contagious disease;
- f) The boxes in which the eggs are packed for export are new, unused and clean, and contain only the eggs certified in this certificate;
- g) The vehicles for the transport of the eggs have been cleaned and disinfected prior to use in accordance with EU legislation.
