I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) on (date), being within 24 hours prior to export, I have examined the day old birds for export and found no signs of infectious or contagious disease, and in my opinion the birds are fit for the intended journey;
- b) the hatchery is a member of the government supervised Poultry Health Scheme, which implements standards of biosecurity and management in accordance with Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2035, and as such it is subject to routine inspection visits by an official veterinarian;
- c) EITHER *(i) The United Kingdom is free from Newcastle disease (ND)
 and Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in
 accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health
 (WOAH);
 - OR *(ii) The flock(s) of origin and the hatchery are in a zone
 which is free from ND and HPAI in poultry (poultry as
 defined by WOAH Animal Health Terrestrial code);

d) the hatching eggs used for the production of the day old chicks/poults had their surfaces sanitised in accordance with WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code as soon as possible after collection using an approved sanitising agent in accordance with manufacturer`s instructions:
