I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) on (date), being within 24 hours prior to export, I have examined the day old birds for export and found no signs of infectious or contagious disease, and in my opinion the birds are fit for the intended journey;
- b) the hatchery is a member of the government supervised **Poultry Health Scheme**, which implements standards of biosecurity and management in accordance with Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2035, and as such it is subject to routine inspection visits by an official veterinarian;
- c) **EITHER** * (i) The United Kingdom is free from **Newcastle disease** (ND) and **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza** (HPAI) in accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH);
OR * (ii) The flock(s) of origin and the hatchery are in a zone which is free from **ND** and **HPAI** in poultry (poultry as defined by WOAH Animal Health Terrestrial code);
OR * (iii) The flock(s) of origin and the hatchery are in an approved poultry compartment which is free from **ND** and **HPAI**;
- d) the hatching eggs used for the production of the day old chicks/poults had their surfaces sanitised in accordance with WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code as soon as possible after collection using an approved sanitising agent in accordance with manufacturer's instructions:
EITHER * (i) fumigation with formaldehyde
OR * (ii) spraying with or immersion in an egg shell disinfectant (please specify the details in the below table)

- e) the flock(s) of origin is/are a member of the government supervised **Poultry Health Scheme**, which implements standards of biosecurity and management in accordance with Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2035, and as such they are subject to routine inspection visits by an official veterinarian;
- f) the flock(s) of origin is/are member(s) of the Government supervised Poultry Health Scheme and as such they have been routinely tested for **Salmonella pullorum** (pullorum disease), **Salmonella gallinarum** (fowl typhoid) and **Mycoplasma gallisepticum** with negative results in each case for the past 6 months;
- g) **EITHER** *(i) the day old chicks have not been vaccinated for **Newcastle disease**
OR *(ii) the day old chicks have been vaccinated for **Newcastle disease** using an authorised vaccine as follows:

- h) the day old chicks have not been vaccinated for **avian influenza**;
- i) I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter stating that:
 - (i) the day old birds will be packed for export in containers which are new, clean and unused;
 - (ii) the day old birds will be transported in conditions which conform to International Air Transport Association (IATA) rules for the welfare of animals in transit.
