- the flocks of origin are subject to microbiological scrutiny by b) sampling at the hatchery for pullorum disease (Salmonella pullorum) and fowl typhoid (Salmonella gallinarum) under a government controlled and statutory monitoring scheme and have given negative results in each case during the past 6 months;
- there has been no evidence of Marek's disease in the flocks of origin during the past 6 months, and the flocks have been routinely vaccinated for Marek's disease;
- there has been no evidence of Infectious Bursal Disease (Gumboro disease) in the flocks of origin during the past 6 months, and the flocks have been routinely vaccinated for Infectious Bursal Disease;
- e) there has been no evidence of Epidemic Tremor (Avian Encephalomyelitis), Avian Leucosis complex and Osteopetrosis in the flocks of origin during the past 12 months;
- f) ETTHER
 - the flocks of origin have been inspected within 24 hours prior to the intended time of despatch and found to be in good health and free from any signs or symptoms of infectious or contagious disease;

- *(ii) the flocks of origin are subject to a routine inspection by an official veterinarian at least once per month,
- a report has been received from each flock manager within 24 AND hours of the intended time of despatch comprising up to date production and mortality records, and physical indicators of flock health and condition,
- according to all this information the flocks of origin are in good health and free from any signs or symptoms of infectious or contagious disease.
