I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- (a) I have on this day inspected the day-old poults at paragraph I above and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease and fit for the intended journey;
- (b) the farms of origin and the hatchery at paragraphs II (b) and (c) above are under regular official inspection and are members of a Government supervised poultry health scheme and are officially considered free from **Salmonella pullorum (pullorum disease), S.gallinarum (fowl typhoid) and S.arizonae, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and M.meleagridis** on the basis of routine monitoring carried out under this scheme, which is in compliance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC and article 6.4.9 of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code, with consistent negative results during the past 6 months; .
- (c) The turkey poults at paragraph I above have been kept in a **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)** free country, zone or compartment since they were hatched AND their parent flocks have been kept in a HPAI free country, zone or compartment for at least the 21 days prior to the collection of the eggs from which the day-old poults for export originate;
- (d) vaccination against **avian influenza** is not permitted in the United Kingdom, except in zoo birds in accordance with EU legislation;
- (e) the turkey poults at paragraph I above and their parent flock(s) at have not been vaccinated against **avian influenza**;
- (f) The turkey poults at paragraph I above were hatched and kept in a **Newcastle Disease (ND)** free country, zone or compartment AND they derive from parent flock(s) which have been kept in a Newcastle Disease free country, zone or compartment for at least 21 days prior to and at the time of the collection of the eggs from which the day-old poults for export originate;
- (g) EITHER
  - \*(i) The day old poults have not been vaccinated for **Newcastle disease**;
  - OR
  - \*(ii) the day old poults have been vaccinated for **Newcastle disease** using the following DEFRA authorised vaccine which complies with the rules of the OIE Terrestrial Manual:
