**IV. Health Information**

- a) The flocks of origin from which the day-old birds are derived were, at the time of egg collection, in either a country, region, or poultry compartment officially free from **notifiable avian influenza** and **Newcastle disease** according to the criteria of the OIE;
- b) The day-old birds were hatched in either a country, region, or poultry compartment which is officially free from **notifiable avian influenza** and **Newcastle disease** according to the criteria of the OIE;
- c) The flocks of origin are subject to a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC, with **negative results** for **Salmonella pullorum, S.gallinarum,**

**\* and (in the case of turkeys only), also for Mycoplasma meleagridis and S.Arizona;**

- d) The flocks of origin have undergone a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Regulation 2160/2003 for **Salmonella enteritidis, S.typhimurium, S.infantis, S.virchow, and S.hadar,** with negative results for these agents;
- e) The flocks of origin are subject to routine monthly veterinary inspection in accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC, do not show any signs or suspicion of contagious disease and fully satisfy the animal health conditions governing intra-community trade in poultry;
- f) The boxes in which the chicks are packed for export are new, unused and clean, and contain only the chicks certified in this certificate;
- g) The vehicles for the transport of the chicks have been cleaned and disinfected prior to use in accordance with EU legislation;
- h) The birds are derived from a hatchery subject to routine veterinary supervision in which effective measures are taken for the prevention of aspergillosis;
- i) \*In the case of chickens only, the day-olds have been vaccinated against Marek's diseases using (product), (type of vaccine) (batch number);
- j) \*In the case of chickens only, the flocks of origin have been vaccinated against Newcastle Disease and Infectious Bursal Disease using an inactivated vaccine immediately prior to the point of lay;
