IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that the day old birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) I have on this day inspected the birds described above and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, and in my opinion fit for the intended journey;
- b) on _____ (date), being within 28 days prior to export of the birds, the farm(s) of origin was/were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- c) the day old birds originate in
either (i) the UK*
or (ii) a region of the UK*
which is officially free from Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (fowl plague) according to the criteria of the OIE Code;
- d) the day old birds originate in
either (i) the UK*
or (ii) a region of the UK*
which has been continuously free from Newcastle disease for the past twelve (12) months prior to the date of export;
- e) the farm of origin is registered by the veterinary competent authority of the United Kingdom;
- f) no case of duck viral enteritis, duck viral hepatitis, fowl cholera, infectious bronchitis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious bursal disease, Marek's disease, egg drop syndrome, swollen head syndrome, avian encephalomyelitis, salmonellosis or mycoplasmosis had been diagnosed or occurred on the farm of origin during the twelve (12) months prior to export;
- g) in the case of day old chicks and turkey poults, the farm(s) of origin are members of the Poultry Health Scheme, which is a Government supervised health scheme, and on the basis of regular microbiological testing they are considered free for Salmonella enteritidis and Salmonella typhimurium as they have given negative results in each case during the past 6 months;
- h) the day old chicks and turkey poults were hatched from eggs derived from a registered farm which is considered to be free from Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella enteritidis, Salmonella gallinarum and Salmonella typhimurium;
- j) the hatching eggs from which the birds were derived and incubators used in the hatchery were fumigated, or disinfected with an officially approved disinfectant according to the manufacturer's instructions, prior to incubation;

k) the day old birds were hatched in a hatchery registered by and under the supervision of the veterinary authority of the United Kingdom and no eggs from other farms of different health status have been hatched in the same incubator at the same time;

l) the birds were packed direct from the incubator in the hatchery into satisfactory clean and new disposable boxes for export, and had no contact with any bird other than day-old birds originating from the same hatchery;

m) EITHER (i) * the day old birds have not been vaccinated;
OR (ii)* the day old birds have been vaccinated against the following diseases on the following dates using vaccine(s) licensed for use in the United Kingdom in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions:
