I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the farm of origin meet the following requirements:

- a) on (date), being within 28 days prior to export of the chicks, the farm(s) of origin was/were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;

- b) no case of duck viral enteritis, duck viral hepatitis, fowl cholera, infectious bronchitis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious bursal disease, Marek's disease, egg drop syndrome, swollen head syndrome, avian encephalomyelitis, salmonellosis or mycoplasmosis had been diagnosed or occurred on the farm of origin during the twelve (12) months prior to export;
- c) the farm(s) of origin is registered and under supervision of the relevant Veterinary Competent Authority of the United Kingdom;
- d) in the case of day old chicks, the farm(s) of origin are members of the Poultry Health Scheme, which is a Government supervised health scheme, and on the basis of regular microbiological testing they are considered free for Salmonella gallinarum, Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella enteritidis, and Salmonella typhimurium as they have given negative results in each case during the past 6 months.
- e) the hatching eggs from which the birds were derived and incubators used in the hatchery were fumigated, or disinfected with an officially approved disinfectant according to the manufacturer's instructions, prior to incubation;
