I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that the hatching eggs described above meet the following requirements:

- a) on _____ (date), being within 28 days prior to export of the hatching eggs, the farm(s) of origin was/were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- b) the hatching eggs originate in
either (i) the UK*
or (ii) a region of the UK*
which is officially free from Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (fowl plague) according to the criteria of the OIE Code;
- c) the hatching eggs originate in
either (i) the UK*
or (ii) a region of the UK*
which has been continuously free from Newcastle disease for the past twelve (12) months prior to the date of export;
- d) in the case of domestic fowl, chicken, turkey or quail eggs*, the eggs originate from registered farm(s) which are considered to be free from *Salmonella pullorum* and *Salmonella enteritidis* and where during the twelve (12) months prior to export no case had been diagnosed or occurred of: **infectious bronchitis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious bursal disease, Marek's disease, egg drop syndrome, swollen head syndrome, avian encephalomyelitis, salmonellosis and mycoplasmosis;**
- e) in the case of duck or goose eggs* the eggs were derived from a registered farm which has been free from duck viral enteritidis and duck viral hepatitis in the twelve (12) months prior to export;
- f) the farm(s) of origin is registered by the veterinary competent authority of the United Kingdom;
- g) the hatching eggs destined for export to Malaysia were sanitized as soon as possible after collection using an approved product according to the manufacturer's instructions and packed direct into satisfactory clean and new disposable boxes for export;
- h) the hatching eggs destined for export to Malaysia have not been inoculated with any microorganisms nor otherwise contaminated with any pathogenic organisms;

j) EITHER (i) * the hatching eggs have not been subject to in ovo vaccination;

OR (ii)* the hatching eggs have been subject to in ovo vaccination against the following diseases on the following dates using a vaccine licensed for use in the United Kingdom in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions:
