I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the farm of origin meet the following requirements:

- a) on (date), being within 28 days prior to export of the eggs, the farm(s) of origin was/were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- b) in the case of domestic fowl, chicken, turkey or quail eggs\*, there has been no history or clinical evidence of the following diseases in the farm(s) of origin during the past 12 months prior to export: **infectious bronchitis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious bursal disease, Marek's disease, egg drop syndrome, swollen head syndrome, avian encephalomyelitis, salmonellosis and mycoplasmosis;**

- c) in the case of duck or goose eggs\* the eggs were derived from a registered farm which has been free from **duck viral enteritidis and duck viral hepatitis** in the twelve (12) months prior to export;
- d) the farm(s) of origin are registered and under supervision of the relevant Veterinary Competent Authority of the United Kingdom;
- e) the hatching eggs were sanitized as soon as possible after collection using an approved product according to the manufacturer's instructions.
