the flocks from which the day old chicks originate:

(ii) have not shown any clinical signs of **avian influenza** infection during the last 21 days immediately prior to consignment of the day old chicks;

- b) there has been no history or clinical evidence of the following diseases on the premises of origin during the past 12 months: Newcastle disease (including velogenic, viscerotropic strains), fowl cholera, Salmonella pullorum (pullorum disease or bacillary white diarrhoea), Salmonella gallinarum (fowl typhoid), chronic respiratory disease, avian encephalomyelitis, infectious synovitis, infectious bronchitis, infectious laryngotracheitis, psittacosis (ornithosis);
- there has been no history or clinical evidence of the following diseases on the premises of origin during the past 12 months:

 duck plague (duck viral enteritis), avian pasteurellosis (avian haemorrhagic septicaemia), avian paratyphoid (avian salmonellosis), duck viral hepatitis;
- d) no new birds have been added to the flock(s) of origin within 30 days prior to despatch;
