- esuspicion of contagious disease;
- The boxes in which the eggs/birds are packed for export are new, f) unused and clean, and contain only the birds certified in this certificate;
- The vehicles for the transport of the eggs/birds have been cleaned and disinfected prior to use in accordance with EU legislation.
