I, the undersigned, certify that the hatching eggs/birds described above meet the following requirements:

FORM III CONDITIONS

- a) there has been no evidence of any of the following diseases in the flock(s) of origin during the past 12 months: avian leucosis, Newcastle disease, Salmonella pullorum, salmonellosis, mycoplasmosis;
- b) The flock(s) of origin have been subjected to the tests in Schedule 1 of the Pakistan import conditions, namely Salmonella pullorum and Mycoplasmosis, with negative results; specifically the flock(s) of origin are members of the government supervised Poultry Health Scheme, and as such they are regularly monitored for the presence of Salmonella pullorum, S.gallinarum, and Mycoplasma gallisepticum and they have given negative results in every case for the past 6 months;
- c)* (Applies only to day old birds; delete in the case of hatching eggs)the day old birds were hatched in incubators which were properly fumigated and disinfected prior to incubation; and after hatching they were packed for export into clean, new boxes and separators without coming into contact with any birds of lower health status;
- d)* (Applies only to hatching eggs; delete in the case of day old birds)the hatching eggs are derived from flocks which have been subjected to the tests in Schedule 1 of the Pakistan import conditions, namely Salmonella pullorum and Mycoplasmosis, with negative results, as described in paragraph IV (b) above;
- e)* (Applies only to day old birds; delete in the case of hatching eggs) the chicks were hatched from eggs obtained from flocks free from pullorum disease and salmonellosis, as described in paragraph IV (b) above;

GENERAL HEALTH CONDITIONS

- f) no case of **highly pathogenic avian influenza** has been confirmed in the flock(s) of origin, nor at the hatchery, nor within a radius of 25 kms thereof, during the 3 months prior to export.
- g) no case of Newcastle disease has been confirmed in the flock(s) of origin, nor at the hatchery, nor within a radius of 25 kms thereof, during the 3 months prior to export.
- h) the flocks of origin are regularly monitored for the presence of **Salmonella enteritidis and S. typhimurium** (salmonellosis) under a statutory government supervised scheme and have given negative results in every case during the past 6 months.
- k) on (date), being within 30 days prior to export, the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin have been inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
