I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) The birds originate from a **hatchery and flocks of origin** in which none of the following have been diagnosed in the 90 days prior to export: Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (Fowl Plague), Newcastle Disease, Fowl Cholera, Salmonellosis (including S.pullorum and S.gallinarum infection), Mycoplasma gallisepticum infection and Fowlpox.
- b) No outbreak of Newcastle Disease or Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (Fowl Plague) has been confirmed in poultry at the holding of origin or within a 10 kms radius thereof during the 90 days prior to export
- c) The birds will be transported in clean boxes which have not been used previously.
- d) The birds were examined within 24 hours of shipment, and they were found to be healthy and no evidence or clinical signs of contagious disease was found.
- e) The birds are vaccinated against Mareks Disease with Rispens and HVT.
