- b) The flock(s) of origin and hatchery are members of a Government supervised Poultry Health Scheme which implements EU Directive 2009/158/EC, and in compliance with which they are regularly monitored for the following diseases with negative results in each case for the past 12 months:

- (i) in the case of chickens, **Salmonella pullorum**, **Salmonella gallinarum**, and **Mycoplasma gallisepticum**;
- (ii) in the case of turkeys, **Salmonella pullorum**, **Salmonella gallinarum**, **Salmonella arizonae**, **Mycoplasma gallisepticum** and **Mycoplasma meleagridis**;
- (iii) in the case of ducks, **Salmonella pullorum** and **Salmonella gallinarum**;
