I, the undersigned, certify that the day old birds/hatching eggs described above meet the following requirements:

- a)* I have this day inspected the day old birds for export and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;

- b) The day old birds/hatching eggs originate from :

Either* (i) The United Kingdom

Or* (ii) A Region of the United Kingdom

which is officially free from **notifiable avian influenza** according to the criteria of the OIE Code;

- c) The United Kingdom is officially free from **Newcastle disease** (as defined in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code) as follows:

The United Kingdom has been free from Newcastle disease for at least three years since the date of the last outbreak;

The United Kingdom has been free from Newcastle disease for at least six months and all the outbreaks in the previous three years have been eradicated by a stamping out (cull) policy with or without vaccination being applied;

- f) the flock(s) of origin of the *hatching eggs/*the day old birds has/have not been vaccinated against **Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Salmonella typhimurium** or **Salmonella enteritidis**;

- *g) the day old birds for export have not been vaccinated against **Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Salmonella typhimurium** or **Salmonella enteritidis**;

h) the flock(s) of origin have been free from the following infectious and contagious diseases for at least 6 months:

Avian lymphoid leukosis, inclusion body hepatitis and vibronic hepatitis (fibrous hepatitis), Pasteurella multocida (fowl cholera), avian encephalomyelitis (AE) (epidemic tremble), Mycoplasma, infectious bronchitis (IB), infectious laryngotracheitis (ILT), infectious bursal disease (IBD) (Gumboro disease), infectious turkey rhinotracheitis (TRT); egg drop syndrome (EDS); viral arthritis (Reovirus), Avian tuberculosis, chicken (fowl) pox, infectious chicken anaemia disease, Marek's disease and psittacosis;

i)* **Either*** the day old birds for export have been vaccinated against **Marek's** disease;
