I, the undersigned, certify that the hatching eggs described above meet the following requirements:

a) the flock(s) of origin is/are *a member(s) of a Government supervised poultry health scheme and has/have been free from Salmonella pullorum (white diarrhoea) and Salmonella gallinarum (fowl typhoid) for at least two years;

the flock(s) is/are free of **Salmonella pullorum/gallinarum**(pullorum disease or white diarrhoea and fowl typhoid) and tested negative by rapid agglutination test;

- c) the flock(s) of origin of the *hatching eggs has/have <u>not</u> been vaccinated against Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Salmonella typhimurium or Salmonella enteriditis;
- d) the flock(s) of origin have been free from the following infectious and contagious diseases for at least 6 months: Avian lymphoid leukosis, inclusion body hepatitis and vibrionic hepatitis (fibrous hepatitis), Pasteurella multocida (fowl cholera), avian encephalomyelitis (AE) (epidemic tremble), Mycoplasma, infectious bronchitis (IB), infectious laryngotracheitis (ILT), infectious bursal disease (IBD) (Gumboro disease), infectious turkey rhinotracheitis (TRT); egg drop syndrome (EDS); viral arthritis (Reovirus), Avian tuberculosis, chicken (fowl) pox, infectious chicken anaemia disease, Marek's disease and psittacosis;
