I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the flock of origin meet the following requirements:

- a)* (delete if not applicable)
In cases where the flock(s) of origin at paragraph III above were imported into the United Kingdom, this took place in accordance with veterinary conditions that are at least as strict as the relevant requirements of Directive 2009/158/EC and any subsidiary decisions, and have not been vaccinated against avian influenza;
- b) they have been held more than six weeks in officially approved establishments for which, at the time of consignment of the hatching eggs to the hatchery, the approval was not suspended or withdrawn;

c) they present, this day, no clinical signs of or grounds for suspecting any disease;

d) they have been submitted to a disease surveillance programme for :

(i)* *Salmonella pullorum*, *S. gallinarum* and *Mycoplasma gallisepticum* (chickens),

(ii)* *Salmonella arizonae*, *S. pullorum* and *S. gallinarum*, *Mycoplasma meleagridis* and *M.gallisepticum* (turkeys),

(iii)* *Salmonella pullorum* and *S. gallinarum* (guinea fowls, quails, pheasants, partridges and ducks)

according to Chapter III of Annex II of Directive 2009/158/EC and were not found to be infected, nor showed any grounds for suspecting infection, by these agents. The flocks have also been examined and showed no clinical signs of or grounds for suspecting infection with *Mycoplasma synoviae*;

e) EITHER (i)* they have not been vaccinated against Newcastle disease

OR (ii)* they have been vaccinated against Newcastle disease using:

f) they have been vaccinated, using officially approved vaccines (if necessary attach a separate schedule)

g) the eggs, from which the birds for export were hatched, were marked prior to consignment to the hatchery in accordance with the instructions of competent authority;

**h) the eggs from which the birds for export were hatched were disinfected as soon as possible after collection in accordance with the instructions of the competent authority;

i) The flocks of origin have undergone a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Regulation 2160/2003 for **Salmonella enteritidis, S.typhimurium, S.infantis, S.virchow, and S.hadar**, with negative results for these agents; as well as **S. Kentucky**. The date of last sampling for which the result is available was ;

♦*j) The flocks of origin are subject to a routine disease surveillance programme for *Mycoplasma synoviae* and upon examination showed no clinical signs of or grounds for suspecting disease;

k) As such the progeny chicks/poults/ducklings of the flocks at Section III above are expected to be free of the pathogens listed in paragraphs IV d), i) and j) above.
