I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) the flock(s) of origin is/are a member of the Poultry Health Scheme, which is a Government supervised health scheme, and it is/they are routinely tested for **Salmonella pullorum** and **Salmonella gallinarum** with negative results for the past 6 months
- b) the flock(s) of origin has/have been routinely vaccinated against **Gumboro disease** (infectious bursal disease) and were revaccinated with a killed vaccine prior to the point of lay;
- c) the flock(s) of origin is/are a member of the Poultry Health Scheme, which is a Government supervised health scheme, and it is/they are routinely tested for **Mycoplasma gallisepticum** with negative results for the past 6 months
- d) there has been no evidence of the following diseases in the flock(s) of origin during the 6 months prior to despatch:
Salmonella pullorum, Salmonellosis (other serotypes), Mycoplasmosis, avian leucosis, avian influenza (fowl plague), Newcastle disease (fowl pest), avian infectious bronchitis, avian infectious laryngotracheitis, fowl cholera;
- e) the flock(s) of origin has/have been vaccinated against **Marek's disease** using government authorised vaccines which conform to the OIE standards as follows:

f) No cases of highly pathogenic notifiable **avian influenza** (fowl plague) have been confirmed at the flocks of origin or the hatchery, or within a radius of 25 kms thereof, during the past 30 days;
