 Marek's disease; Leucosis; Avian tuberculosis; Infectious laryngotracheitis; Chicken infectious anemia; Infectious bronchitis; adenovirus infections and reovirus infections; Turkey rhinotracheitis (TRT); Coryza (Haemophilus paragallinarm); Egg drop syndrome (EDS); Ornithosis (psittacosis); Duck viral enteritis (Duck plague); Goose parvovirus infection (Derzy's disease); Viral hepatitis (inclusion body hepatitis);

paramyxovirus and coronavirus; Blackhead disease; Salmonellosis (Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum and Salmonella typhimurium, S.enteritidis and other zoonotic Salmonella species); Pasteurellosis; Mycoplasma gallisepticum; and other acute infectious diseases;

- c) (i) IN THE CASE OF CHICKENS AND TURKEYS ONLY*
 the flock(s) of origin participate in regular testing under a
 government supervised national control programme for Salmonella
 typhimurium and S. enteritidis and other zoonotic Salmonella
 species, in full compliance with European Commission Regulation
 2160/2003, and have shown negative results in each case for the
 past 6 months;
 - (ii) IN THE CASE OF DUCKS ONLY*
 the flock(s) of origin conduct regular testing for Salmonella
 typhimurium and S. enteritidis and other zoonotic Salmonella
 species, following a similar programme to that laid down for
 breeding chickens in European Commission Regulation 2160/2003,
 and have shown negative results in each case for the past 6
 months;
- d) *the hatching eggs were disinfected or fumigated as soon as possible after collection according to a method in accordance with the Office International d'Epizooties (OIE) Terrestrial Animal Health Code and as soon as possible before import into Ukraine.
