**IV. Health Information**

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that the hatching eggs/day old chicks described above meet the following requirements:

- a) Avian Influenza and Newcastle Disease are statutory notifiable diseases in the United Kingdom and are controlled by a stamping out policy.
- b) The flocks of origin and the hatchery are officially free from **notifiable avian influenza (NAI)** according to the criteria of the OIE for at least the last three months;
- c) The flocks of origin and the hatchery are officially free from **Newcastle disease** according to the criteria of the OIE for at least the last three months;
- d) The UK applies a stamping out policy for HPAI and Newcastle disease and no case of highly pathogenic avian influenza or Newcastle Disease was confirmed in the zone of at least 25 km radius around the premises of origin of the hatching eggs / day old birds and the hatchery in the three (3) months preceding the collection of eggs;
- e) The premises of origin for the hatching eggs/day old chicks applies the Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points System (HACCP) or equivalent;
- f) the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin have been kept in the UK for at least the last 6 months or since hatching and are subject to routine monthly official veterinary inspection and have not shown any signs or suspicion of contagious disease over the last three months;
- g) either the flock(s) of origin was not immunised during the last 3 months preceding the collection of the eggs for export\*,  
Or  
The flock of origin was immunised during the last three months preceding the collection of the eggs with the vaccines and on the dates below:\*
- h) The boxes in which the eggs/birds are packed for export are new, unused and clean, and contain only the eggs/birds certified in this certificate;

j) the eggs were disinfected as soon as possible after collection following a method approved by the World Animal Health Organisation (OIE) and laid down in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code;

k) The vehicles for the transport of the eggs/birds have been cleaned and disinfected prior to use in accordance with UK legislation.
