II. HEALTH INFORMATION

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that the pet animal/s of the genera species described above meet/s the following requirements:

1. the pet animal/s originate from the UK, where rabies is subject to compulsory notification;
2. the pet animal/s has remained in UK since birth or at least six months before dispatch in the holding/s of origin before dispatch to Denmark and are not intended to be sold or transferred to another owner;
3. the pet animal/s is/are not to be killed under a national programme for the eradication of diseases;
4. the vehicles or containers in which the animal/s was/were loaded were cleaned and disinfected before loading with an officially authorised disinfectant;
5. the pet animal/s was/were examined by an official or approved veterinarian within 24 hours of loading and showed no clinical sign of disease;
6. the pet animal/s was/were loaded for dispatch to Denmark on⁽¹⁾ in the means of transport described under reference box I.15 above that were cleaned and disinfected before loading with an officially authorised disinfectant and so constructed that faeces, urine, litter or fodder could not flow or fall out of the vehicle or container during transportation.

Animal transport attestation

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify the pet animal/s described above has/have been treated before and at the time of loading in accordance with the relevant provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No 1/2005, and in particular as regards watering and feeding.

Please note:

One certificate must be used for each species; the original/s must accompany the animal/s to their destination. It is considered as pet animals if it is for 5 or fewer animals.

This certificate is valid for 10 working days.

⁽¹⁾ Date of loading: import of animals will not be allowed if they are loaded either prior to the date of authorisation for export to Denmark or during a period where restrictive measures have been adopted by the European Community/Denmark against imports of pet animals of the genera species from the UK.
