- c) the flock(s) of origin is/are members of a Government supervised poultry health scheme, and have been routinely tested for the following diseases with negative results in each case during the past 6 months;

     Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Mycoplasma
     gallisepticum;
- d) there has been no history or clinical evidence of the following diseases at the premises of origin during the past 6 months:

  Salmonella gallinarum (fowl typhoid), Salmonella pullorum (pullorum disease), Gumboro disease, infectious bronchitis, avian encephalomyelitis, Marek's disease, and fowl pox, duck virus enteritis, duck virus hepatitis;

  - which is officially free from notifiable avian influenza according to the criteria of the OIE;
