IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that the day old birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) I have today inspected the day old birds for export and found them to be healthy and free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, and in my opinion fit for the intended journey;
- b) on _____, being within 30 days prior to export, the flock(s) of origin were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- c) the flock(s) of origin is/are members of a Government supervised poultry health scheme, and have been routinely tested for the following diseases with negative results in each case during the past 6 months:
- (i) in the case of chickens:
Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Mycoplasma gallisepticum;
 - (ii) in the case of ducks:
Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum;
- d) there has been no history or clinical evidence of the following diseases at the premises of origin during the past 6 months:
Salmonella gallinarum (fowl typhoid), Salmonella pullorum (pullorum disease), Gumboro disease, infectious bronchitis, avian encephalomyelitis, Marek's disease, and fowl pox, duck virus enteritis, duck virus hepatitis;
- e) the flock(s) of origin and the hatchery are located in
either (i) the UK*
or (ii) a region within the UK*
which is officially free from notifiable avian influenza according to the criteria of the OIE;
- f) no outbreak of **Newcastle disease** has been confirmed at the premises of origin nor at the hatchery nor within a radius of 25 kms thereof during the past 3 (three) months;

 the day old chicks have been vaccinated against **Marek's disease** using an authorised product in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions as follows:

- h) the day old birds for export have been hatched in incubators which were fumigated or disinfected prior to use, and during and since incubation the birds have not had any contact with other birds apart from those of the same health status;
- j) a written declaration has been received from the owner/exporter stating that the birds will be packed for export in clean, new and unused boxes and that they will have no contact with birds other than day old poultry of the same health status.
