IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that the hatching eggs/day old birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) on (date), all the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- b) no outbreak of **Newcastle disease** has been confirmed at the premises of origin, or at the hatchery, or within radius of 10 kms thereof, during the past 30 days;
- c) to the best of my knowledge and belief and after due enquiry there have been no cases of **pasteurellosis** (fowl cholera) or **tuberculosis** at the premises of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 12 months;
- d) to the best of my knowledge and belief and after due enquiry there has been no mortality greater than 2% due to **Marek's disease** in the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 12 months;
- e) to the best of my knowledge and belief and after due enquiry there have been no cases of **infectious laryngotracheitis** at the premises of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 12 months;
- f) the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above are subject to regular bacteriological testing under a statutory government scheme for **Salmonella enteritidis** and have given negative results in each case during the past 12 months.
- g) the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above are members of a government supervised poultry health scheme under which they are subject to regular routine bacteriological testing for **Salmonella pullorum and S.gallinarum** and have given negative results in each case during the past 12 months.
- h) to the best of my knowledge and belief and after inspecting all relevant reports of post mortem and laboratory examinations there have been no cases of avian vibrionic hepatitis at the premises of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 12 months;
- j) no case of low pathogenic avian influenza has been confirmed at the premises of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 3 months;

- k) The day old chicks/hatching eggs originate from EITHER* (i) a country
 OR* (ii) a region
 OR* (iii) a compartment
 which is free from highly pathogenic avian influenza according to the criteria of the OIE Code.
- the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above are held within closed houses which are secure against the entry of wild birds;
 - m) all hatching eggs are subject to systematic disinfection by an officially approved method before being admitted to the hatchery at paragraph II (c) above;
 - n) the day old chicks have been incubated and hatched and packed for export without coming into contact with any other birds apart from those of a similar health status;
 - o) the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above have not shown any clinical signs of **avian influenza** during the 21 days immediately prior to export;
 - p) the day old chicks/hatching eggs are packed for transport in containers which are new, clean and unused;
 - q) to the best of my knowledge and belief and after due enquiry there have been no cases of avian encephalomyelitis, duck virus hepatitis, or duck virus enteritis at the premises of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 12 months;
 - r) the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above are members of a government supervised poultry health scheme under which they are subject to regular routine serological testing for Mycoplasma gallisepticum and have given negative results in each case during the past 12 months.
 - s) the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above are subject to regular serological testing at a government approved laboratory for **Mycoplasma synoviae** with sample numbers sufficient to give 95% confidence of detecting infection at 5% prevalence and have given negative results in each case during the past 12 months.
 - t) the flocks of origin at paragraph II (b) above have not shown any clinical signs of **infectious bronchitis** or **infectious bursal disease** during the 21 days immediately prior to collection of the eggs from which the day old chicks for export were hatched;
 - u) to the best of my knowledge and belief and after due enquiry there have been no cases of avian leucosis or egg drop syndrome (EDS '76) at the premises of origin at paragraph II (b) above during the past 12 months;
 - v) the hatching eggs/day old chicks for export have been kept in isolated conditions and have not come into contact with any other eggs or birds prior to export apart from those of a similar health status;
 - w) the day old chicks/hatching eggs originate from premises which are free from Foot and Mouth disease and free from movement restrictions due to Foot and Mouth disease.
 - x)* I have on this day inspected the said day old chicks and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious and contagious disease, and in my opinion fit for the intended journey;
