I, the undersigned, certify that:

- (a) after due enquiry and following receipt of a written declaration from the owner/agent of the owner, the said animal has been continuously resident in the United Kingdom:

EITHER* (i) since birth;

OR* (ii) for a minimum period of 6 months immediately prior to export;

- (b) the dog described above was examined and found to be clinically healthy and fit to travel;

- (c) as far as can be ascertained and following receipt of a written declaration from the owner/agent of the owner, the said animal has not been in contact with any animal showing clinical signs of any infectious or contagious disease including **Aujeszky's disease, filariasis, leptospirosis, rabies, canine distemper, infectious hepatitis, canine parvovirus infection and dermatomycosis** during the past 3 months immediately prior to export;

- (d) the United Kingdom is officially free of **rabies** according to the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) Terrestrial Animal Health Code;

- (e) on (date), being within 30 days of export a blood sample was taken from the animal and submitted to a government/government authorised laboratory and subjected to either an *Antigen ELISA or *the microfilaria filtration test for **Dirofilaria immitis** (Heartworm), with a negative result;

- (f) on (date), being within 30 days of export, a blood sample was taken from the animal and submitted to a government/government authorised laboratory where it was subjected to either an *indirect fluorescent antibody test (IFAT) or an *antibody ELISA for Leishmaniosis, with a negative result;
