IV. Health Information:

I, (full name and qualifications in block letters) an Official Veterinarian of the United Kingdom do hereby certify that:

- (a) the *poultry meat (including raw meat preparations) /*meat products /*mechanically separated meat is derived from clinically healthy birds that originate from premises and administrative territory(ies) officially free from the following Notifiable diseases (as defined in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code):
 - Notifiable Avian Influenza;
 - ii) Newcastle disease;
- (b) the *poultry meat/*meat products/*mechanically separated meat described herein was obtained from poultry which were submitted to ante and post mortem inspection under veterinary supervision and found to be free from any clinical evidence of infectious or contagious disease of the species;
- (c) The *slaughterhouse(s), *cutting plant(s), *processing plant(s) and *cold store plant(s) at Section II above are not subject to animal health restrictions arising from Notifiable diseases under European Union (EU) law;
- (d) the *meat/*meat products/*mechanically separated meat has been dressed, prepared and packed under hygienic conditions in accordance with regulations at present in force in the European Union (EU);

- (e) on the basis of legislation currently in force in the European Union, it can be considered that the *meat/*meat products /*mechanically separated meat does not contain levels exceeding the limits permitted in the European Union of any veterinary medicinal product, antiparasitic agent, heavy metal or chemical contaminant; and does not contain any beta-agonist or any substances having a thyrostatic, oestrogenic, androgenic or gestogenic action which do not occur naturally in the meat;
- no substances derived from the other species (e.g. bovine, ovine or porcine proteins) have been added to this meat;
- the *meat/*meat products/*mechanically separated meat originate from poultry not slaughtered as part of a disease eradication program/measure;
- (h) *meat/*meat products/*mechanically separated meat are considered fit for human consumption.
