I, the undersigned, certify that the animal described above meets the following requirements:

- a) on (date), (being not more than 72 hours prior to the proposed date of export), the said animal was examined and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, including ectoparasitism, and in my opinion is fit to travel;
