- I, the undersigned, hereby certify that:
- the consignment described in Paragraph I. is fit for human consumption and 1. was produced in accordance with EU legislation;

- 6. the meat/poultrymeat (and meat/poultrymeat used in the manufacture of preparations/products) was derived from animals which originated from holdings on which none of the following OIE-listed diseases, to which the species of origin is susceptible, have been confirmed: African swine fever, classical swine fever, foot and mouth disease, swine vesicular disease, Newcastle disease or avian influenza.
