- c) the processing establishment where the said products/preparations were prepared has been approved by the relevant food authority of Great Britain for the export of meat products/preparations to the European Union;
- d) the said products/preparations have been manufactured in a hygienic manner so as to prevent their contamination with any agents known to cause infectious diseases of domestic animals/poultry and do not contain additives or colouring matter injurious to health;
- e) the products/preparations have been produced, packaged, stored and transported within Great Britain in a sanitary manner so as to prevent contamination with the causative agents of any infectious animal/poultry disease;
- f) the meat used in the manufacture of the product/preparations does not originate from holdings in an area which is under restriction due to an outbreak of any OIE List A disease to which the animal species named at I a) above is susceptible;
- g) the meat products/preparations are oval marked to denote that they are acceptable for human and animal consumption in the United Kingdom and the European Union.
- h) the meat used in the manufacture of the product/preparations originates from animals slaughtered after 1 August 2002.
