I,
an Official Veterinarian of the United Kingdom do hereby certify that:

- a) the poultry meat within the commodity to be exported was obtained from clinically healthy poultry which were submitted to ante and post mortem inspection under veterinary supervision and found to be free from any clinical evidence of infectious or contagious disease of the species;
- b) the commodity to be exported has been prepared under hygienic conditions in accordance with UK regulations and is considered fit for human consumption;
- c) the meat within the commodity to be exported came from a flock that has not tested positive for *Salmonella spp.* in the last 30 days before slaughter;
- d) the poultry meat within the commodity to be exported was derived from birds that originated from a zone not under restriction due to outbreaks of **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)** and **Newcastle disease** in poultry;
- e) the meat production premises are not in an area or zone where **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)** and **Newcastle disease** were detected within the past 30 days prior to slaughter, and until the issue of the certificate.
