II. HEALTH ATTESTATION I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that the collagen described in this certificate was produced in accordance with the following requirements: II.1. It has been derived exclusively from bovine skins of animals that were slaughtered in an official slaughter house and found fit for human consumption following ante- and post-mortem inspection; II.2. a traceability system is in place to ensure that finished collagen gel, casing or film can be traced back to the raw materials used; II.3. deliveries of the raw materials are accompanied by the necessary veterinary certification. II.4. the production facilities are officially approved under the United Kingdom Hygiene Regulations to produce collagen for human consumption. II.5. It has been subjected to an alkali treatment of a pH of 12 or greater for at least 16 hours, followed by a pH of 3 or less for at least 24 hours prior to shipment. II.6. The product complies with the required microbiological standards for collagen in the United Kingdom. II.7. After manufacture, the product was stored under appropriate hygiene conditions and the necessary measures were taken to avoid contamination.
