IV. ANIMAL HEALTH ATTESTATION

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that:

1. the products in the consignment described at Paragraph I. bear oval marks or were made with ingredients that bear oval marks which demonstrates that they are fit for human consumption & produced in accordance with EU legislation.
2. UK law prohibits the sale or supply of milk from cows affected or suspected of being affected with Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy;
3. the feeding of ruminant protein to ruminants is prohibited in the United Kingdom;
4. the United Kingdom has a comprehensive programme in place to monitor radioactivity in food and the environment. The results demonstrates that even the most exposed members of the UK public received radiation doses from consumption of local food and exposure to environmental radioactivity (due to discharges and direct radiation) that were below the statutory EU annual dose limit to members of the public of 1 millisievert per year from artificially-produced radionuclides as set in the Council Directive 96/29/Euratom of 13 May 1996;

5. the meat/poultrymeat (and meat/poultrymeat used in the manufacture of preparations/products) was derived from animals which originated from holdings on which none of the following former OIE List A diseases to which the species of origin is susceptible have been confirmed: African swine fever, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, Newcastle disease or avian influenza.
