obtained from poultry which were submitted to ante and post
mortem inspection under veterinary supervision and found to be
free from any clinical evidence of infectious or contagious
disease of the species;

(c) The slaughterhouse (s) cutting plant(s), processing plant(s)
and cold store plant(s) at Section II above are not subject to
animal health restrictions arising from Notifiable diseases
under European Union (EU) law;

- (d) the *meat/*meat products has(have) been dressed, prepared and packed under hygienic conditions in accordance with regulations at present in force in the European Union (EU);
- (e) on the basis of legislation currently in force in the European Union, it can be considered that the *meat/*meat products does (do) not contain levels exceeding the limits permitted in the European Union of any veterinary medicinal product, antiparasitic agent, or heavy metal, metal products or chemical contaminant; and does not contain any beta-agonist or any substances having a thyrostatic, oestrogenic, androgenic or gestogenic action which do not occur naturally in the meat;
- (f) no substances derived from the other species (e.g. bovine, ovine or porcine proteins) have been added to this meat;
- (g) the *meat/*meat products is(are) considered to be free from pathogen agents, specially Salmonellas;
- h) the *meat/*meat products originate(s) from poultry not slaughtered as part of a disease eradication program/measure;
- i) the *meat/*meat products originate(s) from poultry not vaccinated with any live vaccine during the 30 days prior to slaughtering;
- j) the *meat/*meat products is(are) considered fit for human consumption.
