- I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that the meat/meat products described above meet the following conditions:
- * (i) for export of bovine, ovine and caprine meat the meat/meat products were (a) derived from animals which, at the time of their slaughter, were resident erritory that has been free from rinderpest and foot and mouth disease in a (FMD) for the past 12 months;
 - export of porcine meat the meat/meat products were derived from *(ii) for animals which, at the time of their slaughter, were resident in a territory that has been free from rinderpest, FMD, African swine fever and classical swine fever for the past 12 months;
- they originate from the United Kingdom and/or were legally imported into the (b) United Kingdom;
- they were derived from animals that have not been slaughtered for the purpose of (C) disease eradication or disease control;
- they were derived from animals that have been subjected to satisfactory antemortem and post-mortem inspection under veterinary supervision in an officially (d) approved slaughterhouse;
- the meat/meat products and/or the packaging thereof bears an official mark (e)indicating that they have been obtained processed, packaged, labelled and stored in officially approved establishments in accordance with relevant food hygiene regulations and are fit for human consumption;
- they do not contain levels exceeding permitted limits of veterinary medicinal products and residues and comply with microbiological criteria in accordance with (f) food law and instructions given by the competent authorities of the United Kingdom;
- they have been stored in an hygienic manner so as to prevent (g) ontamination with agents known to cause infectious disease of humans or animal
- the transport vehicles or containers and the loading conditions of consignment meet the conditions laid down in the relevant hygiene regulations;

* IN THE CASE OF BEEF PRODUCTS:

the bovine meat and/or meat product meets the conditions laid down in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code Chapter on bovine spongiform encephalopathy 0 (BSE).
