JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint in respect of holiday pay is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
- 2. The complaint of breach of contract in relation to notice of termination fails and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of unfair dismissal is well founded. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 4. Any basic and compensatory awards for unfair dismissal shall be reduced by 75% on account of contributory fault by the claimant.
- 5. Any compensatory award for unfair dismissal shall be reduced by 80% to reflect the chance that a fair appeal would have confirmed dismissal.
- 6. The parties having agreed terms of settlement as to remedy, the Tribunal makes no order or award of compensation for unfair dismissal. All proceedings as to remedy will be dismissed without further order with effect from 4pm on **Friday 19 October 2018** unless before that time either party has notified the tribunal in writing that it does not wish this paragraph of the judgment to take effect.
