I, the undersigned, certify that:

- (1) the milk products described overleaf were obtained from milk produced in accordance with the requirements of the European Union (EU) legislation laying down hygiene rules for food of animal origin and its official controls and that it is oval marked as fit for human consumption. The animals were healthy at the time of collection. The milk products have been prepared in a plant approved for export to the European Union;
- (2) Either
  - \*i) the United Kingdom is recognised by the Office International des Epizooties (OIE) as a country free from foot and mouth disease, without vaccination; Or
  - \*ii) the milk has been subjected to a procedure which ensures inactivation of the foot and mouth disease, as set out in the OIE code.
- (3) the products have been handled, processed and packed under hygienic conditions and heat treated in accordance with regulations currently in force in the United Kingdom;
- (4) the United Kingdom has a comprehensive programme in place to monitor radioactivity in food and the environment. The results demonstrates that even the most exposed members of the UK public received radiation doses from consumption of local food and exposure to environmental radioactivity (due to discharges and direct radiation) that were below the statutory EU annual dose limit to members of the public of 1 millisievert per year from artificially-produced radionuclides as set in the Council Directive 96/29/Euratom of 13 May 1996;
- (5) The United Kingdom has a residue surveillance programme in place to ensure that milk, including milk used in milk products, is free from harmful levels of residues of antibiotics (below the Maximum Residue Limit - MRL), hormones (below MRL), pesticides (below MRL), or any other substances known to be harmful to human health;
- (6) I have received a declaration from the exporter of the consignment described overleaf which states that the products were manufactured from natural
