JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's claim of breach of contract (notice pay) is well founded and succeeds. The claimant is awarded the sum of **£442.30**.
2. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£2388**. This is made up of the sum of **£1548** (net of income tax and National Insurance Contributions) in respect of unpaid wages and **£840** gross unpaid commission (which commission would be subject to the payment of any income tax and National Insurance Contributions thereon)
3. The claimant's claim for accrued holiday pay is also well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of **£796.15** (subject to the payment of any income tax and National Insurance Contributions thereon).
