I, the undersigned official veterinarian hereby certify that:

1. The producer is an establishment which is approved by the State Veterinary Services for the local market as well as for export to Israel and is supervised by an official or accredited veterinarian;
2. The products described above have been derived from animals⁽¹⁾/ fetuses recovered from animals⁽¹⁾ which:
 - (a) originated from herds/farms/establishments which were free from Anthrax for at least 12 months, and from diseases specific to the species included in the former List A of the OIE code in a radius of 30 kms for at least 6 months prior to slaughter; and
 - (b) ⁽¹⁾either [- were slaughtered and their carcasses are fit for human consumption in accordance with the exporting country's legislation;]
 - ⁽¹⁾or [- were slaughtered in a slaughterhouses, after undergoing ante-mortem inspection, and were considered fit, as a result of such inspection, for slaughter for human consumption in accordance with the exporting country legislation;]
 - ⁽¹⁾or [- did not show any clinical signs of any disease communicable to humans or animals through the hide or skin, and were not killed to eradicate any epizootic disease;]
3. The products described above have been:
 - (a) dry-salted or wet-salted for at least 14 days prior to exportation⁽¹⁾, or
 - (b) salted for 7 days in sea salt with addition of sodium carbonate to 2%⁽¹⁾, or
 - (c) dried for 42 days at a temperature for at least 20°C⁽¹⁾;
4. The products described above have undergone all precautions to avoid recontamination with pathogenic agents after treatment and have not been in contact with any other animal product or live animals.
