NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE EXPORTER AND THE VETERINARY OFFICER

IMPORTANT

These notes provide guidance to veterinary officers and exporters. The NFG should have been issued to you together with export certificate 5993EHC. The NFG should not be read as a standalone document but in conjunction with certificate 5993EHC. We strongly suggest that exporters obtain full details of the importing country's requirements from the veterinary authorities in the country concerned, or their representatives in the UK, in advance of each consignment.

1. SCOPE OF THE CERTIFICATE

Export health certificate 5993EHC may be used for the export of calcined water-ground porcine bone ash for the production of ceramics

2. CERTIFICATION BY A VETERINARY OFFICER (VO)

This certificate may be signed by a full time veterinary officer of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, Scottish Government, Welsh Government or Department of Agriculture and Rural Development Northern Ireland (DARDNI).

Veterinary Officers should sign and stamp the health certificate with their official stamp in any colour **OTHER THAN BLACK**.

A certified copy of the completed certificate must be sent to the Centre for International Trade - Carlisle or to DARD within seven days and a copy kept for his/her own record keeping purposes.

3. DECLARATION

A declaration that the product has been processed correctly must be signed by an authorised signatory of the exporting company and accompany the export health certificate.

DISCLAIMER

4. This certificate is provided on the basis of information available at the time and may not necessarily comply fully with the requirements of the importing country. It is the exporter's responsibility to check the certificate against any relevant import permit or any advice provided by the competent authority in the importing country.
