I, the undersigned, certify that:

- (a) the hides or skins have been obtained from cloven-hoofed animals such as cattle, ovine or caprine that were slaughtered in a slaughterhouse. The animals underwent official ante and post mortem inspection by government veterinarian and proven to be healthy;
- (b)\* there has been no outbreak of rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease and African swine fever in the UK for at least two years prior to shipment;
- (c) if the requirements laid down in paragraph IV(b) have not been met, the products described at paragraph I. above, have been subjected to one of the following treatments and kept separate from untreated hides and skins:

- 1.\* salting for at least 28 days with sea salt containing 2% sodium carbonate. However, in case of dried hides are disinfected by formalin gas; **and** (only in the case of dried hides)\* disinfected by formaline gas, **or**
- 2.\* soaking, with agitation, in an alkaline solution of pH 11.5 or above, such as 4% (w/v) solution of sodium carbonate, for at least 48 hours; **or,**
- 3.\* soaking, with agitation, in an acid solution of pH 3.0 or less, such as a formic acid solution (100kg salt [NaCl] and 12kg formic acid per 1000 litres of water), for at least 48 hours.
