 - 3. in accordance with Council Decision 2000/766/EC, products containing processed animal protein (other than fishmeal and certain other specific material which meets certain specific criteria, in which case they may be fed to non-ruminants) cannot be fed to farmed animals which are kept, fattened or bred for the production of food;
